



Mission Statement

Abbeville Area Medical Center maintains compliance with the Payment Card Industry Data Security Standard (PCI DSS). The purpose of the Merchant Credit Card Policy is to protect our customers' credit card data and personal information shared for the sole purpose of settling amounts owed to the facility. Any information obtained will be used only for the purpose of processing credit card transactions and will not be retained.

Background

PCI DSS was established by the credit card industry in response to an increase in identity theft and credit card fraud. Every merchant who handles credit card data is responsible for safeguarding that information and can be held liable for security compromises.

Chargebacks

In the unlikely event that an error is made or a credit card account is being used fraudulently, the payment processor will notify a merchant of a disputed charge. The merchant is responsible for providing the bank with written proof that the transaction was authorized by the customer.

Refunds

In the unlikely event that an error is made, or in such case that refund may be due, the refund must be credited only to the same account from which the payment was made. In addition, it is not permissible for a cash refund to be made.
