What is Best Chance Network?

Breast and cervical cancer screening at no cost for South Carolina women who qualify.

Best Chance Network Services

Patients can be referred for individual (breast/cervical/BC) or multiple services

Cervical cancer yearly services include: (this occurs on the mobile Clemson bus with an NFP)

- Pap Smear and Pelvic Examination
- ✓ Co-testing with Pap test and HPV panel
- ✓ HPV genotyping 16 & 18
- ✓ Counseling visit for all high-grade abnormal results
- LEEP or conization procedure, as indicated
- ✓ Referral to treatment
- ✓ Nurse Navigation Services

Breast Cancer services:

- ✓ Clinical breast exams
- ✓ Screening mammograms (BCN covers 3D mammography)
- Diagnostic testing, if necessary
- ✓ Referral to treatment
- ✓ Nurse Navigation Services

Birth Control that can be provided at BCN visit (New Morning Foundation for ChooseWell)

- ✓ LARCS (IUD and Nexplanon)- same day insertion
- ✓ Gamete (Depo, pills, etc.)

Eligibility Requirements

- 1) SCResident
- 2) Between ages of 30-64 (breast cancer screening) & between the ages of 21 and 64 (cervical cancer screening)
- Have a household income that is at or below 250% of the federal poverty limit. (handout with household size and income level to help communicate with patient).
- 4) Women who meet the three requirements above and who also have health insurance may be eligible for BCN if:
 - Insurance has a deductible of \$1,000 or higher
 - Insurance that does not cover screenings and diagnostics at 100%
 - Insurance covers hospitalization only
