## Diabetes management through healthy food and nutrition education

Are you 18 years or older and currently living with diabetes? The **Fresh For Life** program can help you manage your diabetes usinghealthy foods and nutrition education.

## Eligibility and what to expect

- o Twice monthly produce boxes with fresh fruits, vegetables and recipes
- o Four individual health and nutrition coaching sessions with a registered dietitian
- o Once monthly food and cooking demonstrations
- o Resources to help you continue a healthy diet and lifestyle
- o Monitoring of clinical measures (including A1C) to track your progress!
- This program is free of charge, and you will be compensated for your time; total incentive value is \$245
- Eligibility based on qualifying A1C value and income threshold (for example, you are SNAP eligible).
