The **Community Resource Center** (CRC) is a service of Abbeville Area Medical Center's Community Health, Wellness and Outreach department. Developed with our community in mind, the **CRC** is a place that bridges the gap between individuals and families and healthcare services by providing resources, referrals, information and support that are designed to help enhance quality of life.

Services include chronic care management, diabetes education, a variety of mobile health clinics and the ability to connect those in need with numerous community resources.

What we Provide



Diabetes Education

Our Diabetes Education Program is designed to give people with diabetes the tools and information they need to better care for themselves.

Classes are one-on-one, taught by a Certified Diabetes Educator and available to those with pre-diabetes, Type 1, Type 2, and Gestational diabetes.

Classes include:

- Diabetes Self-Management
- Insulin Therapy Evaluation, Initiation & Follow-Up
- Gestational Diabetes Management

Weekly insulin pump groups and professional continuous glucose monitoring systems are also offered.

A physician referral is needed. Our program is recognized by the American Diabetes Association.



Chronic Care Management

The Chronic Care Management Program (CCM) helps Medicare patients who are experiencing multiple chronic health conditions start their journey to wellness. It also helps ease the sometimes difficult and frustrating task of keeping track of medications, appointments, follow-ups and testing for both the patient and family members involved in their care.

Benefits include:

- Creation of a personalized, comprehensive care plan to help meet health goals
- Monthly check-ins from a designated chronic care coordinator
- Medication management assistance
- Easy access to a chronic care coordinator to answer questions or concerns
- 24/7 access to a healthcare provider to address chronic conditions
- Preventive service and immunization reminders
- Establishing new care with medical specialists



Mobile Health Clinics

Mobile health clinics bring expanded, high quality health services to rural communities that serve mostly uninsured and underinsured populations. All mobile health clinics are FREE based on eligibility requirements.

Mobile Health Clinics include:

- **Best Chance Network**
Breast & cervical cancer screening at no cost for South Carolina women who qualify. Provided in conjunction with Clemson Rural Health Services.
- **Fresh for Life**
On-site registered dietitian led prescription produce program for those with type 2 diabetes.
- **Goodwill Mission Mobile**
Offers job connection services such as access to training tools, skills assessments, and job search and application assistance. Provided in conjunction with Goodwill.

Eligibility Requirements

A male or female that is between the age of 18-64 and living at 200% below the poverty level. No financial documentation is required. The referral is usually placed by your healthcare provider. All results from mobile health clinic are sent back to your healthcare provider.

Community Outreach

Our **CRC** team can help with access to a wide variety of resources located within our community so that you can take control of your health and wellbeing.

These include:

- **Anna's Closet**
This program collects new or gently worn work attire and accessories that are made available to individuals who are in need of appropriate clothing. Food items and personal hygiene supplies are also accepted to support those in need.
- **SC Thrive**
Connects people to crucial benefits like access to fresh foods, tax preparation services, health insurance and other healthcare resources, money management classes and resources for seniors, military and veterans.
- **AccessHealth Lakelands**
Provides case management by certified Community Health Workers, establishment and coordination of primary care providers and assistance with other barriers to obtaining optimal health.
- **Second Harvest Food Bank**
Partners with the CRC to provide free monthly food box giveaways.

- **FoodShare**
In partnership with the University of South Carolina School of Medicine, an affordable fresh food box program that can be purchased for pick up twice monthly. \$20.00-credit/debit or \$5.00 SNAP/EBT.
- **Colorectal Cancer Prevention Network**
In partnership with the University of South Carolina, provides low-cost colorectal education, screenings and follow up. Physician referral required.
- **Lions Vision Services**
Partners with the CRC to provide affordable eyeglasses, low-vision assistive technologies, eye surgery and vision screenings.
- **Workforce Wellness**
Program that provides a wide variety of services designed to assist any size business or industry to keep its workforce well and working.
- **Health Fairs**
Contact us if your church, business or organization is interested in scheduling a health fair.
- **Screenings and Preventative Services**
Assistance with resources that can provide an array of health-related wellness services.
- **Be Well Abbeville Coalition**
This Coalition includes many agencies and individuals that provide support and health resources from across our area.
